

I. Golf Course and Practice Facilities Rules – 2010

Proper Attire

1. Members and guest of members are required to be properly attired while on the golf course and while using practice facilities.
2. Jeans, “cutoffs” and sweat suits have been determined by the membership to be inappropriate attire for the golf course and practice facility.
3. Bermuda shorts, less than 3 inches above the knee for men and lower than mid-thigh for woman are appropriate attire.
4. Proper golf shirts must be worn. T-shirts, fishnet see-through shirts, halter-tops and bathing suit tops are not proper golf shirts.
5. Acceptable golf shoes are required at all times.
6. Members are expected to use good judgment in dressing for golf. As fashions are subject to change, it is suggested that members first check with the golf professional for guidance as to whether a fashion statement is appropriate.

Carts

1. Carts should be driven on the cart path or rough.
2. Carts should be driven on the cart path only for par 3 holes.
3. Drivers should observe the 90-degree rule.
4. Carts are to come no closer to the greens than the posts that are erected near each green.
5. Carts should avoid excessively wet areas during inclement weather.

Rules

Members should observe good golf etiquette including replacing divots and repairing ball marks.

Clubhouse, Grillroom and Deck

1. The clubhouse and grillroom are No Smoking Areas.
2. Hats are to be removed when entering the grillroom or dining room.
3. Proper attire is required for members and their guest(s) in the clubhouse, grillroom or on the deck. Shoes or sandals must be worn.
